Letter of Acknowledgement

The Liberia Anti- Corruption Commission (LACC) present its compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of the Liberia Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (LEITI) report for the period January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

However, in a cover letter accompanying the LEITI report dated January 12, 2026, you requested the LACC to review and probe into two suspected cases of alleged fraudulent acts as identified by the Multi-Stakeholder Groups (MSG).

In view of the above, the Commission writes to inform you that said request has been considered and forwarded to the Monitoring and Investigation Department (MID) of the LACC for a full-scale investigation to establish the facts and circumstances surrounding allegations.

At the same time, LACC requests a meeting at your offices on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. The purpose of this meeting is to furnish us with copies of tax payment and financial records, particularly those relating to transactions exceeding USD 17 million between ArcelorMittal and the Liberia Revenue Authority (LRA), as well as transactions exceeding USD 500,000 connected to the Liberia Petroleum Regulatory Agency (LPRA).

The Commission appreciates and acknowledges your contribution in the fight against corruption.
