RE: CALL FOR NOMINATION

The LEITI Secretariat wishes to inform you that the current MSG of LEITI tenure will expire on October 19, 2021. Section 6.6 of the LEITI Act sets the tenure of MSG members to a renewable term of three (3) years. Accordingly, in keeping with the law, the President of Liberia appointed members of the current MSG on October 19, 2018, thereby ending their tenure on October 19, 2021.

Section 6.5 of the 2009 Act states, "Members of the MSG shall be appointed by the President who shall designate one of them as chairperson and the other as co-chairperson. In the appointment of members of the MSG to represent civil society and the private sector, the President should hold appropriate consultations with members of the group".

In recognition of the above, the current MSG, in its last sitting, approved the period July 15 - September 15, 2021, as the period for election and nomination of individuals that will represent the various constituents on the next LEITI MSG.

We, therefore, request the Mining Companies to nominate an individual that will represent them on the next MSG. LEITI Secretariat would appreciate a report including meeting minutes on how the individual was selected to represent the Mining Companies at the end of the process.

The LEITI Secretariat will appreciate your urgent consideration of this process to prevent us from having an incomplete MSG when other blocs of the MSG have completed their nominations for presidential appointments. You can contact the LEITI Secretariat in case you need additional information.

Kindly allow us to have your response before the close of the business day on Wednesday, October 6, 2021.

We look forward to a peaceful and transparent election and nomination process.
